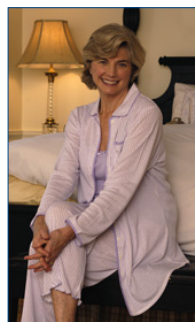


Holiday Gift Ideas for Seniors

Knit Lite, Crochet Lite and Scissor Lite:

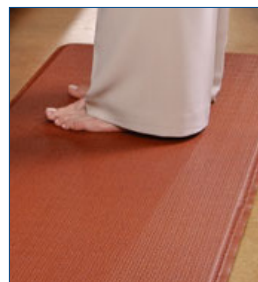

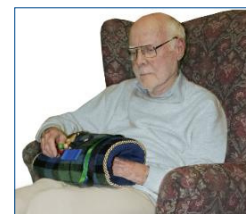

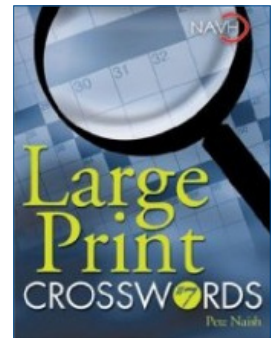
