- Coordination of services inside or outside the home
- Providing assessments and ongoing counseling
- Updating family members and professionals on the plan of care
- Ensuring that there is an adequate stock of food, medications and medical supplies in the home
- Serving as a contact person for physicians, EMS and emergency room staff in the case of a medical emergency
